Transportation

Individual transport from Newark Airport to Jersey City is best by using Uber or Lyft. JC is a few miles from Newark Airport and the ride generally takes 20 minutes.

However, you can take the AirTrain from EWR to Newark Penn Station – then switch to the PATH train system. You should get off the PATH train at Exchange Place and you will be steps from the hotel.
